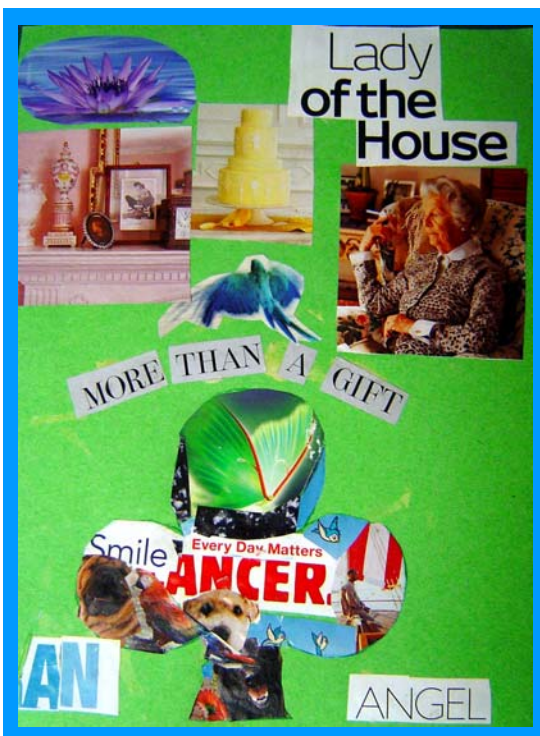




Signs of a Grieving Child

- Academic performance has declined.
- Attention span decreases: child cannot focus on specific tasks/no longer have an interest in things they once enjoyed.
- Sleeping problems: cannot sleep alone, nightmares/ terrors, does not sleep as much or is sleeping too much.
- Fighting more with siblings, surviving family members, and/or peers.
- Clinging more, does not want to be left alone.
- Does not talk about the person they are missing.

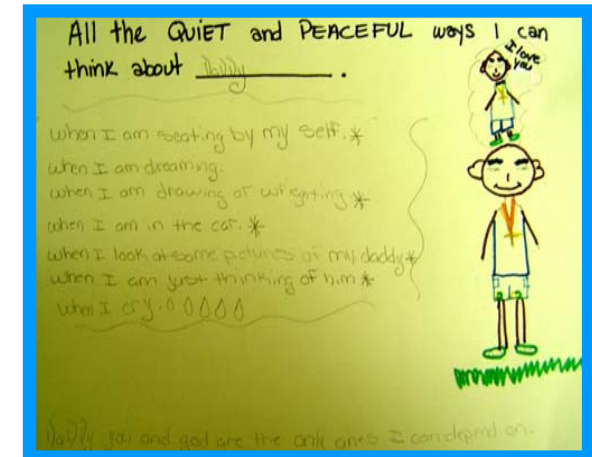
